STUDENT-PARENT TIMELINE FOR VOC-REHAB SERVICES

- 1. Student and parent sign Voc-Rehab (VR) referral form at student's IEP meeting within 18 months of high school graduation.
- 2. VR Counselor receives the referral and will send student-parent an introductory letter introducing themselves and explain in detail the services that VR may be able to provide.
- 3. If the student-parent is interested in APPLYING FOR VR SERVICES they will need to call the phone number provided at the bottom of the letter received from the VR Counselor.
- 4. Student-Parent will call the phone number and APPLY FOR SERVICES.
- 5. VR will send an application in the mail to the student.
- 6. Student will fill out the application and return it in the self-addressed, stamped envelope provided by the VR Counselor.
- 7. VR Counselor will call student-parent to make an appointment with student for an interview.
- 8. VR Counselor will come to the school and interview the student to make a determination if student qualifies for services under the current Voc-Rehab qualifying criteria.
- 9. Student will receive a determination letter from VR, stating that they either qualify for services or they do not.
- 10. If student qualifies for services, the VR Counselor will order vocational and academic testing for the student, and together they will write a PERSONAL EMPLOYMENT PLAN (PEP).
- 11. If student has any questions about their PEP they are encouraged to call their VR Counselor at any time.
- 12. Students are also encouraged to call and check in with their VR Counselor every three to four weeks to see how their PEP is progressing.
